Focusing on the presentation this morning by Professor Maria Clara Lucchetti Bingemer.

Question 1

"The Word of God ... frees the human being from the mute violence of instincts, from routine, from the immediate. It provokes freedom by opening up space to transform the world and it leads those who listen to it along a transformative path that will lead to an ever more powerful and fulfilling life.":

Question 2

Question 3:

"In the early days of its existence, the community of Jesus' disciples were known as 'disciples of the way'. This is because Jesus doesn't teach a philosophy, an ideology, but a way, in other words, a road that must be travelled with him, on which one learns only by taking it, by walking."

"... Jesus says: 'I am the Way'. The way, therefore, is his person. It is his way of acting, thinking, feeling and listening."
